Michelle Diane Jividen Memorial Scholarship

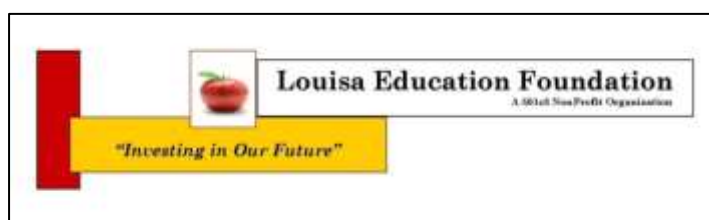
Michelle Jividen dedicated her life to the service of Louisa's youth and families through education. She was passionate about her commitment to church and family, and found great joy singing with the Charlottesville Women's Choir. Michelle understood the value of service to her community and made a difference in many ways.

To honor Michelle, her parents and other family members are offering a Five Hundred Dollar (\$500.00) scholarship to any worthy senior with aspirations in the field of education. Qualified students will submit an application with a personal statement that includes the reason for pursuing a career in education, and who or what inspired them to make that decision. In addition, applicants will describe what goals they plan to accomplish in their professional career in education, and why they feel that they are the best candidates to receive this award.

Michelle believed that community service was an important part of being connected, and she felt that it made her a more complete individual. In order to give to her students, she felt that she needed to be fulfilled and energized, so she could remain a positive role model for them. As part of the personal statement, applicants should include information about their service to their school, church and/or community.

LEF's scholarship committee will review the application. Students interested in applying for this scholarship should contact their guidance counselor or go to the Louisa County High School or Louisa Education Foundation websites to download an application. The absolute deadline for submitting this application to LCHS Guidance is April 1, 2016. The recipient of this year's scholarship will be announced at Senior Awards Night in May.
